24564 HARRIMAN, Stearns Miles - 2 Oct 1917 inducted into the U.S. Army as a mechanic, Batry E, 303 FA; disch. 1 May 1919; overseas service 16 Jul 1918- 26 Apr 1919.

24519 HARRIMAN, Perley W. - 27 Aug 1918 inducted into 31st Co., 8th ME Tng Bn 151; died of disease 21 Oct 1918.

24512 HARRIMAN, Leroy Dewey - 6 Jun 1917 enlisted in the National Guard as a private 1st class, Co. L, 2nd ME Infantry during World War I; discharge 18 Jun 1919; service overseas (Sep 1917- Jun 1919_ in France: Xivray-Mense; Bois des Mans; Chateau-Thierry; Aisne-Marne; Somme Offensive; St. Mihiel; Meuse-Argonne; wounded in action 21 Jul 1918; service during World War I and World War II.

31058 HARRIMAN, Percy Granville - 29 Mar 1917 third class fireman for the US Navy; served for about three months during World War I.

24374 HARRIMAN, Winfred Leroy - 29 Apr 1907 enlisted from Fort Slocum, N.Y. in Co. H, 11th Cavalry, for three years, claiming to be age 18; dishonorably discharged in August 1907? (or 8?) at Camp Columbia, Cuba, probably for lying about his age?

26755 HARRIMAN, Parker Wood - 18 Sep 1917 inducted as a private, unassigned, discharged 21 Sep 1917.

26756 HARRIMAN, Russell F. - 24 Jul 1918 "Frank R. Harriman" of Bucksport ME inducted as a private, Co. K, 14th infantry; overseas service during World War I; served in Co. K, 74th Infantry, 12th Div.; discharged at demobilization, 22 Jan 1919.

26964 HARRIMAN, Guy E. - enlisted 24 Feb 1917 as a private first class; Det QMC Ft. Houston TX to Jul 1917; Bkry Co 8 Douglas AZ to Aug 1917; Bkry Co 33 Ca,p Bowie TX to 5 Oct 1917; dishonorable disch. 14 Mar 1919.

24795 HARRIMAN, Ira Howard - inducted as a private 20 Co 5 Bn 151 Dep Brig; discharged 2 Jul 1918.

15142 HARRIMAN, Elon - inducted as a private in 152 Dep Brig; QMC to discharge on 3 Jun 1919.

5313 HARRIMAN, Rodney Dennison - 7 Apr 1917 enlisted in the National Guard as a private, 1st Co., CAC National Guard (on his Jun 1917 draft card, he had served 1-1/2 years), discharged 11 Aug 1917; inducted 25 Jul 1918, in Portland ME, into LB #2 as a private and moved to pvt. 1st class 15 Oct 1918; assigned to Co. B, 36th MG Battalion, Serial #3160882, from which he was discharged 28 Jan 1919. No overseas service.

7627 HARRIMAN, Guy W. - registered for the draft in Tippecanoe County IN and served in World War I.

5444 HARRIMAN, Elmer Eugene - enlisted at Westbrook, Me., as a private, Btry B, 1st ME HvFA to discharge on 14 Aug 1917.

5441 HARRIMAN, John Leslie - enlisted as a private, age 36.

6199 HARRIMAN, George Dana - enlisted as a private, Btry C, 7th FA; wrote to say he was due to be discharged, but never returned home; unknown by family "what ever prevented him from reaching home" (however, see 1920 census of a George Harriman of Berwick ME, b. c. 1899 NH); his military record states discharge due to disability and admitted desertion 16 Jul 1918. He did return to the area and had married Georgianna (Roy) Drown by 1919.

34685 HARRIMAN, Howard Joseph - served during World War I as a musician, 2nd class, for the U.S. Navy.

3714 HARRIMAN, Joseph Donley - 29 Jun 1917 enlisted as a sgt. in the U.S. Army, Sec. 13, Rep. Unit, 322nd Motor Transport Corps; served during World War I from North Dakota and is listed in "Roster of the Men and Women Who Served in the Army or Naval Service (including the Marine Corps) of the United States or Its Allies from the State of North Dakota in the World War, 1917-1918," Vol. 2. 1931, pg. 1251

His brother, Bert, is listed on the same page.

14359 HARRIMAN, Loren Stanley - 1 Oct 1918 inducted at San Jose, Calif.; sent to Stanford University; served in Students Army Training Corps, to discharge. Discharged on Dec. 11, 1918, as a Private; listed on pg. 1251 of "Roster of the Men and Women Who Served in the Army or Naval Service (including the Marine Corps) of the United States or Its Allies from the State of North Dakota in the World War, 1917-1918," Vol. 2. 1931

10066 HARRIMAN, Guy Edwin - serial number 1508609, enlisted at age 18 10/12 years old, private 1st class; Cpl July 18/18. Org: Det QMC Ft Houston Tex to July 13/17; Sch for Bkrs & Cks Ft Houston Tex to July 20/17; Bkry Co 8 Douglas Ariz to Aug. 15/17; Bkry Co 33 Cp Bowie Tex to Oct. 5/17. Overseas service: None. Dishon disch GCMO No. 33: Mar. 14, 1919.

15630 HARRIMAN, Henry Andrew - inducted as a private, Quartermaster Corps to Aug 1918; Sup Co. 328 QMC to Oct 1918; Sup Co 315 QMC to May 1919; disch. 10 Jul 1919; overseas 8 Sep 1918 to 30 Jun 1919, serving during World War I.

16015 HARRIMAN, Louden Augustus - 5 Aug 1917 a chaplain and 1st Lt., U.S. Army, Indiana Infantry, serving during World War I; earlier service is recorded on back side of headstone applc., indicating first enlisted in Jun 1916.

20732 HARRIMAN, Paul Dearborn - 22 Jul 1918 enlisted as a yeoman 1st class in the U.S. Naval Reserve Forces, Boston Navy Yard.

25715 HARRIMAN, Everett Milton - inducted as a private into F Hosp. 304 Sn Tn 301 to Dec 29, 1918, then transferred to MD Cp Hosp to discharge 9 Jul 1919; overseas 11 Jul 1918- 28 Jun 1919, with service during World War I.

10827 HARRIMAN, Franklin Downs - served in WWI in the U.S. Army as a private, H. Q. Co. 12 BN 166 Dept. B. R. I. G., from Idaho.

7097 HARRIMAN, William H. - 8 Mar 1917 enlisted in Co. D, 1st VT Infantry; discharged 14 Apr 1917, by reason of physical disability.

12643 HARRIMAN, Lester Parker - Jun 1917 a cadet, rank of Major, at the University of Nevada.

25782 HARRIMAN, Everett - enlisted, age 19-4/12, in the regular army from Mechanicsville as a private, advancing to Mess Sgt., and served overseas in the U.S. Cavalry in France during World War I.

4972 HARRIMAN, Fred Rufus - served as a private in Co. A, 101st Engineers, during World War I.
